

RFQ Ref# 0184-24: Purchase of Mobile Handsets

Article 1: Scope / Technical Specifications

Purchase of original Samsung S23 & S24, 5G capable, as per below options:

Quantity needed 28. All quantity may be purchased from 1 type of handset or different types.

Article 2: Payment terms

Payment will be made cash in LBP at market rate on payment date as per below:

- 50% upon Purchase order receipt in LBP at market rate on payment date
- 50% upon final delivery in LBP at market rate on payment date

Article 4: Warranty

The offer should include a 1-year warranty.

Article 5: Bid Bond & Performance Bond

- A Bid Bond from the participating bidders' bank to MIC1 with a value of USD 800. The validity of this LG should be 148 days as of offers submission date (shall exceed the Offer's validity by 28 days as per article 34).
- It will be returned to non-selected bidders.

The Bid Bond is ruled by the article 34 of Public Procurement Law 244 dated July 19th 2021. It can be provided as LG from bidders' bank or in Cash.

- Another mandatory Performance bond from winning bidder' bank or cash to MIC1 with a value of 10% of the quoted selected devices should be presented upon tender award only within 15 days from contract start date.
- The performance bond shall remain valid and effective from the date of issuance up to the final delivery.
- The Performance Bond is ruled as by the article 35 of Public Procurement Law 244 dated July 19th, 2021.

Article 6: Offer Validity

The quotations submitted by the Bidders shall be commercially and technically binding for the Bidders for a period of 4 months at least as of the submission Date or any extension of the Closing Date decided by MIC1.

Article 7: Submission

Offers must be **submitted in sealed envelope on Monday March 11th, 2024 at 1 pm**

Sealed Envelope should bear the RFQ ref# 0184-24 and should contain:

- 2 Official stamped and signed offers for S23 and S24 separately including warranty and clear delivery date.
- Bid Bond if issued from a Bank.
- Cash Bid Bond should be deposited in MIC1 accounting department in Dekwaneh, Parallel Towers, Block A, to the attention of Mr. Elias Koussaifi or Mr. Milard Sayed.

Envelopes received after set date and time will be considered disqualified and returned to suppliers.

No prices should be submitted by email.

Article 8: Declaration of Relatives

Suppliers submitting for any RFQ launched by Alfa should declare any relative relations with any Alfa employee up to the 4th degree under Clause 30 of the PPL, for MIC1 to be able to assess the existing of any potential conflict of interests which may lead to deprive the bidder from participating to the tender under the risk of disqualification.

Article 9: Boycott with Israel

Suppliers shall abide by the legal requirements of the Republic of Lebanon concerning the Boycott of Israel in accordance with the law dated June 23rd, 1955.
